Dr. Mladen Vassilev-Missana was born on January 22, 1954 in Vratsa, Bulgaria. His PhD thesis, defended in 1992 in front of the Bulgarian High Testimonial Commission, was dedicated to commutants of lineal differential operators in analytic functions spaces. His research interests are focused on the prime counting function, Riemann zeta function, Bernoulli



numbers, and others. He has been a member of the Editorial Board of NNTDM since the beginning of the Journal in 1995, thus being one of the longest-serving members.



Happy 70th Anniversary to Prof. Krassimir Atanassov!

Prof. Krassimir Atanassov was born on March 23, 1954 in Burgas, Bulgaria. He was the inventor of the mathematical formalisms of intuitionistic fuzzy sets (1983) and generalized nets (1984) as extensions of fuzzy sets and Petri nets, respectively. His research interests in the area of number theory include generalizations of the Fibonacci sequence, properties of arithmetic functions, the algebraic object termed tertion, as

well as some extremal and combinatorial problems. In 1995, he became one of the founders and Editors-in-Chief of two international research journals: "Notes on Intuitionistic Fuzzy Sets" together with Prof. Janusz Kacprzyk and Prof. Humberto Bustince Sola, and our journal "Notes on Number Theory and Discrete Mathematics", together with Prof. Anthony G. Shannon and Prof. József Sándor.
